TERMS AND CONDITION

RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENTS

To reserve space on any trip, submit the enclosed application form with a deposit of \$500. Providing space is still available, you will be sent immediate confirmation and other pre-departure information. You will be invoiced for a second deposit of \$700 which is due 2 months prior to departure, and for the balance of trip cost and airfare, which is due 30 days prior to departure. Your air tickets, trip roster, final bulletin with instructions for meeting the group, and a mail/phone contact abroad will be sent out 3 weeks prior to departure. If payment installments are not made when due, Adventure Bound Expeditions reserves the right to treat the reservation as cancelled. Many trips sell out early; sign-up 2 months prior to departure is advised. Trip cost is generally based upon a minimum number of participants. If the minimum number is not met, Adventure Bound Expeditions reserves the right to cancel the trip to apply a surcharge to trip costs.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

If you must cancel your reservation, your deposit will be returned minus a cancellation fee as follows (computed as of date of our actual receipt of written cancellation notice):

Rates based on group participations and it is understood and agreed that there will be no partial refunds given for unused hotel rooms, trekking arrangements, sightseeing, etc. for any reason whatsoever. If your air tickets were purchased through our office, you will receive whatever refund is allowable under the airline's regulations. We highly recommend that all clients purchase cancellation insurance.

TRIP GRADES

Our trip grading system provides prospective travelers with a guideline for selecting an adventure appropriate to their skills and needs. Individual tolerance to conditions of travel vary considerably. The most important qualities for an adventure traveler include a spirit of adventure, positive attitude, and a desire to explore new places and try new experiences.

Trip grades are as follows:

GRADE I (EASY). Travel by van or bus, short hikes or gentle river floats, and lodging in hotels.

GRADE II (MODERATE). Travel by van or bus, longer day hikes, more challenging river trips, and some camping along with lodging in hotels.

GRADE III (AVERAGE). Camping in dominant, but some hotels are included for convenience. Hikes are longer and more demanding and river trips more challenging. Treks are of short duration (up to 10 days) and at low altitudes, under 10,000 feet. Good health is the major physical requirement.

GRADE IV (DIFFICULT). Camping is dominant, but some hotels are included for convenience. Trips are of longer duration and often include elevations above 10,000 feet or rafting difficult rivers. Previous outdoor experience, camping and hiking, is helpful and a physician's certificate of health is required.

GRADE V (**STRENUOUS**). This grade requires technical experience and skills such as mountaineering, rock climbing, etc. Treks are of long duration (a month or more) and hiking may range to 18,000 feet in elevation.

HEALTH AND FITNESS

The first concern of our trip leaders is safety, comfort, and well being of our clients. We carry a first aid kit; however, medical facilities for serious problems are often unavailable in remote areas. Evacuations can be prolonged, difficult, and expensive. Adventure Bound Expeditions assumes no responsibility or liability regarding provisions of medical care. The trip leader has the right to disqualify anyone at any time if the participant is felt to be physically incapable of endangering the safety of the group. Refunds are not provided under these circumstances.

Personal health is the responsibility of the participants and it is essential that individuals with medical problems or dietary restrictions make them known to us long before departure. You should be in good general health. For some trips, a certificate of health is required. Participants must bring an adequate supply of any special medication required and a personal first aid kit.

Recommended physical fitness requirements vary with each outdoor adventure. Please read the trip description and trip grades carefully and compare them to your general health and past experiences.

INSURANCE

Participants must be covered by medical insurance valid overseas. We recommend that you obtain short-term travelers' insurance covering accident and sickness, emergency evacuation, baggage and trip cancellation. Trip cancellation insurance reimburses you for non-refundable air and land cost should you have to cancel your trip due to personal or family illness.
